## U.S. SENATE RECALL LOOMS IN COLORADO

Secretary of State Office, Denver, Colorado, Tuesday, January 26, 2010

In America today – we have 1 party rule – with 2 gangs of frauds. The American people realize this and that is why a revolution has ensued.

Joe Elector asked what grounds and we were told, "well – statute in the Constitution" – when pressed further on what statute, our petitions were taken, stamped and a receipt was issued. ### Why Recall?

A brief refresher from our Colorado State Constitution, Bill of Rights defines our relationship with our government:

Individual liberty and rights are inherent, and such rights are not derived from the constitution, but belong to the individual by natural endowment. Government derives from surrender of individual rights. Government exists through the surrender by the individual of a portion of his naturally endowed and inherent rights.

The people of this state have the sole and exclusive right of governing themselves, as a free, sovereign and independent state; and to alter and abolish their constitution and form of government whenever they may deem it necessary to their safety and happiness, provided, such change be not repugnant to the constitution of the United States.

Is it not reasonable to expect that our Elected Representation adhere to STATE LAW when they head off to represent us at our capitol offices?
